10. Promoting community-based redevelopment while preventing gentrification.


FUTURE LAND USE MAP

Residents, businesses, and visitors will be protected from flooding.

Headwaters of streams will be protected to mitigate the impact of cloudbursts and flash flooding as well as to improve water quality.

Objective 2.2.7 Protection of sensitive waters.

Sensitive waters such as wetlands, marshes, swamps, and other native habitats will be protected.

Objective 2.2.8 Standards for aquaculture.

There will be standards for aquaculture to ensure it does not further impair our waters but is still a productive and viable process.

Objective 2.2.9 Protect springs.

Our springs will be protected with public access increased where appropriate to further embrace and cherish our restorative springs.

Objective 2.2.10 Restore aquatic ecosystems.

Restore the natural balance and health of aquatic ecosystems through various conservation and restoration efforts, such as reducing pollution, reintroducing native species, and preserving habitats.

All Shenandoah County residents will have access to the latest FCC regulated communications technology.

Objective 9.2.2 Latest FCC internet standards.

All the County will have access to the most recent FCC standards for broadband internet services.

Objective 9.2.3 Integrate AI in everything.

Work to integrate AI into all government functions, private businesses, and other organizations to increase their capacity and efficiency.

Objective 9.2.4 Energy independence and redundancy.

Create backup systems and redundancies in the electric grid as well as energy generation and storage facilities to prevent power outages and ensure reliable access to electricity for residents and businesses without dependence on external energy producers.

Objective 9.2.5 Modernize water infrastructure.

Upgrade the physical infrastructure of water treatment plants, distribution systems, and storage facilities to improve water quality and ensure reliable access to clean water for residents and businesses.

Objective 9.2.6 Advanced waste management.

Implement sustainable waste management practices that minimize waste generation, maximize resource recovery, and reduce the environmental impacts of waste disposal by upgrading the physical infrastructure of waste management systems and promoting coordination and consolidation among waste management agencies.

Improve the physical infrastructure of roads, bridges, and other public structures to make them more resistant to damage from natural disasters or other emergencies.

Provide safe and accessible routes to schools, encouraging active transportation and reducing traffic congestion around school zones

Objective 11.2.10 Gather information.

Consistently update information on pedestrian and bike trails in the County.

Goal 11.3

Street systems will be complete, safe, and connected for all.

Objective 11.3.1 Update policy.

Update the County's and Towns' policies and requirements to ensure that new streets built are designed to accommodate all users including street master plans.

Objective 11.3.2 Compatible land uses.

Land uses along streets will support multimodal transportation.

Objective 11.3.3 Appropriate road sizes.

Improve existing streets with road diets to bring them to appropriate sizes and the implementation of bike and pedestrian infrastructure.

Collaborate with VDOT and private landowners to reduce access barriers to industrial and business locations per the Future Land Use Map.

Ensure that the transportation of freight through the County is done safely for the transporters, visitors, and local community.

Objective 11.4.8 Energy for transportation.

Ensure that energy sources for transportation are readily available throughout the County.

Objective 11.4.9 Affordable transportation repair.

Support access to an array of transportation repair providers to ensure it is affordable to all.

Objective 11.4.10 Gather information.

Consistently update information on tourism and economic development transportation issues in the County.

Goal 11.5

Shared transportation will be a viable option for traveling around and through the County.

Objective 11.5.1 Expand public transportation.

Expand access to ShenGO and other forms of public transportation throughout the County and region.

Objective 11.5.2 Micro-transit options.

Partner with private organizations to provide shared shuttles and minibuses throughout the County and region.

Objective 11.5.3 Support transportation sharing.

Support the establishment of transportation sharing programs such as Zipcar, Bird, or E-Bikes in the County in the Towns, Villages, and Hamlets.
