Board of Supervisors Meeting—Tuesday, 5/12 at 4:00 pm: This serves as a reminder that the Board will meet on Tuesday, 5/12 at 4:00 pm.

Industrial Development Authority (IDA) Meeting—Friday, 5/15 at 9:00 am: The Shenandoah County Industrial Development Authority met today, 5/8 at 9:00 am and has scheduled another meeting for next Friday, 5/15 at 9:00 am. These weekly meetings continue to be scheduled as the IDA administers and reviews applications for its Disaster Impact Loan Program and conducts other IDA business.

Property Tax Billings: Ms. Cindy George, Treasurer, notified us that the 2020 first half property tax bills were mailed on Thursday, 5/7; thus, we anticipate that our citizens will be receiving those bills in the next several days.

Plans for Reopening Public Access to the Government Offices & Facilities: Plans and strategies are currently being developed for the reopening of public access to governmental offices and facilities. Our first order of business is to inventory those offices with public interface and determine what measures can be placed to provide biosecurity (think grocery store plexi-glass style barriers); the general properties department began that process this week. We are also considering other measures such as signage, cleaning protocols, masks/face coverings, etc., which are all matters that need to be accounted for. I do not want to offer a specific date but wanted to advise that we are in the planning process.
