

STONEY CREEK SANITARY DISTRICT

The Stoney Creek Sanitary District provides public water and sewer service to the Bryce Mountain, Basye and Shrine Mont (sewer only) areas of Shenandoah County. The District was established in 1986 by the Shenandoah County Board of Supervisors to assume all assets and responsibilities from the Stoney Creek Utilities Corporation.

The District operates and maintains the following:

Wastewater System

- 600,000 gpd Wastewater Treatment Plant
- UV Disinfection
- Six sewer pump stations
- 320,000 feet sewer lines

Water System

- Four Water Treatment Plants (420,000 gpd capacity)
- Three Water Booster Stations
- Three Water Storage Tanks (439,000 gallons)
- 280,000 feet water lines



The District serves approximately 1,700 connections. The operations and maintenance staff consists of three treatment plant operators and ten construction & maintenance personnel. The administrative staff of the Director, Executive Assistant, Utility Billing Clerk and Utility Clerk provide support for both Stoney Creek Sanitary District and Toms Brook-Maurertown Sanitary District. The FY 2020 budget was \$1.88M, which includes over \$0.5M for Capital Improvements to the water and sewer distribution and collection systems.
