



# East Massanutten Mountain Area Loop Trails

## Trail Information

### Kennedy Peak -

There is a large parking area just above Camp Roosevelt Recreation Area off SR 675. Ride Stephens Trail to Massanutten Trail (May require some walking on Massanutten Trail). There is a short side trip to Kennedy Peak Observation Point. Tie your horse before walking up to the peak. To make the loop, ride back to parking area via Massanutten Trail.

**Parking:** Off SR 675, just above Camp Roosevelt Recreation Area

**Length:** 7.5 mile loop

**Map(s):** Trails Illustrated Map 792, PATC Map G

**Trail Difficulty:** Moderate

**Trail Surface:** rocky in places

**Trail Use Allowed:** Equestrian, Hiking, Mountain Bike

### Habron Gap - Indian Grave Ridge

Park at Habron Gap (Foster's Landing). Ride to Indian Grave Ridge and then ride the state gravel road back to your parking area.

**Parking:** Habron Gap or Fosters Landing (off SR 684 )

**Length:** 9.5 mile loop

**Map(s):** Trails Illustrated Map 792, PATC Map G

**Trail Difficulty:** Moderate - steep in places

**Trail Surface:** rocky, some loose tread

**Trail Use Allowed:** Equestrian, Hiking, Mountain Bike

### Tolliver to Millford Gap Trail.

Park at Burners Bottom to access the Tolliver Trail. Ride to the Millford Gap Trail an old logging road to abandoned Hazard Mill canoe camp. You can also ride an unblazed, non-sustem trail from the canoe camp to the old logging road.

**Parking:** Burners Bottom at turnaround on FDR 236, off SR 717

**Length:** 5.7 mile loop

**Map(s):** Trails Illustrated Map 792, PATC Map G

**Trail Difficulty:** Easy

**Trail Surface:** rocky in places, some loose tread

**Trail Use Allowed:** Equestrian, Hiking, Mountain Bike
